Mr. Beauchamp called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

FY 2000-2001 COUNTY BUDGET

There followed a discussion of the individual cost centers of the FY 01 budget.

The Board agreed to approve, by consensus, all unopposed changes to the draft budget prepared by the county administrator. All other matters were approved by motion.

The Board members asked that the county administrator check with the Commissioner of the Revenue about the possibility of increased assessments based on the belief that Blue Ridge Appraisers did not do a complete job on the reassessment.

Motion was made by Mr. Beauchamp to increase the salary of Glenn Rowe, General Services Director, by 10% from his FY 00 salary. Vote 3 Aye (Beauchamp, Simmons, Frere), 1 Nay (Jenkins).

The Board members asked that the county administrator have Mr. Rowe pay more attention to the Lancaster convenience center by making spot checks to ensure cleanliness and order. It was suggested that Cy Revere could make checks as he comes and goes from the animal shelter.

The Board members asked about the changing amounts of the computer lease. When is the payoff?

The Board members suggested the "dirt room" in the basement of the courthouse might be converted to office space. The county administrator was asked to get prices on this construction.

The Board members asked the county administrator to check on the current prices being received for recycled cardboard.

The Board members asked the county administrator to check to see why some refuse site employees don't wear complete issued uniforms while at work.

The Board members renewed their request to get prices from Bay Transit for Saturday and/or Sunday service in Lancaster County.

Motion was made by Mr. Jenkins not to fund the GOAL program during FY 01. VOTE: 3 Aye (Beauchamp, Simmons, Jenkins), 1 Nay (Frere).

The Board members asked the county administrator to explore changing the subdivision ordinance to require no notice to adjoining property owners and having all subdivisions reviewed at staff level.

The Board members asked about purchasing a digital camera for the Wetlands Board. Mr. Pennell will check on funds available and cost of cameras.
