Jamie Alga supported the sheriff's office and an apparent lack of accountability from the Lancaster County Schools based on information available from its web site. He favors the five cent per \$100 tax increase.

Diane Ryan, GOAL Program stated pouring money into education is not the answer. Children should get one-on-one assistance.

William Ryan stated summer school should be cut out.

Mr. Jenkins explained that the Board of Supervisors control over school board was limited to the amount of funding appropriated during the budget deliberations.

Budget Appropriation to Comprehensive Services Act

The annual appropriations for Community Services Act are \$316,000.

Mr. Beauchamp made a motion to approve the appropriation to the Community Services Act in the amount of \$316,000.
